The AmpleHarvest.org^(SM) Campaign was established in May 2009 with the goal of enabling millions of America's backyard gardeners to quickly find local food pantries in need of fresh produce. It has received support from Google.com, the USDA, food banks, faith organizations as well as writers/bloggers across the country (see www.AmpleHarvest.org/feedback.php) and was highlighted in May 2009 on CNN Heroes program (see www.AmpleHarvest.org/news.php).

Registering your pantry is easy, quick and FREE. Just visit www.AmpleHarvest.org to register your pantry*. In addition to entering the name, address, phone and other information about your pantry, you can also upload a digital photograph of your pantry if you have one, to make it easier to find. You can also list store bought items your pantry most desperately needs, for donors who want to help even when the gardening season is over.

Do not worry if your pantry does not have refrigerated storage. Most pantries arranged for produce donation and client pickup on a same day or next day basis. The new (free!) AmpleHarvest.org iPhone app can even help enable the donation of store bought items.
